The Role

Fairview Veterinary Hospital is seeking to recruit a Registered Veterinary Nurse to join their team!

This is a Full-Time permanent position in a busy fast paced, long established veterinary hospital in Dublin. The role involves a mix of clinical and surgical duties with some minor reception duties from time to time. Your daily responsibilities include prepping for surgical procedures, anaesthetic support, patient recovery, pharmacy work, restraint & handling, client management and other clinical duties. You will be working alongside our excellent team of experienced RVN's and animal care assistants that will support you in your role.

There is a 1 in 3 rota for weekends, with limited workload on the weekend shifts and a half day shift during the week. Our current shift patterns are: 40 hours per week; mornings 9am-1pm and evenings 2pm-6pm alternating with mornings 10am-2pm and evenings 3pm-7pm. There is no OOH with this role.

Salary is up to €34,000 depending on experience.
