The Role

An exciting opportunity has arisen for a Registered Veterinary Nurse to join our team here at Raheny Veterinary Hospital.

At Raheny no 2 days are ever the same, but some duties will include looking after inpatients and making sure surgical patients are looked after throughout their stay. Our nurse shifts vary between inpatient, surgery shifts and floating shifts. You will also be required to dispense medication, assist the surgeons with scans and discharge inpatients to their owners. The working week is flexible with some staff preferring to work longer shifts over a 4-day work week and others preferring to work 8-hour shifts over a 5-day working week. Weekend cover is generally a 1 in 6 Rota without any OOH duties.

Salary for this role is up to €36,000 depending on experience.
